

How to Participate in the Project Squad SciFest on Saturday December 10th?

1. Every participant must **complete a booth form**, and if you still haven't done it, the link is here <https://teen-turn.com/booth/>

2. Once registered, you will **must submit your poster**. Email to contact@teen-turn.com by **Tuesday December 6th**, cover the following, **using the template provided**:

- Prepare to present your project (max 3 minutes) to the judges.
